# Finding a Co-Packer

A guide to help consumer goods entrepreneurs bring their products to market.





## **Things to Know**

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The term co-packer refers to companies that manufacture products on behalf of consumer goods brand owners.



A co-packer provides increased manufacturing capabilities, product expertise and industry connections.

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Co-packers often differ in their approach to pricing, sourcing, storage and finished product shipping.



Brand owners will need to work with a co-packer's minimum order quantities and lead times.



It can be challenging to find co-packers for products that are unique, complex or require small order sizes.



The co-packer and brand owner partnership benefits from a priority on clear communication and common goals.

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# **Getting Started**

#### Plan Ahead

Build brand awareness and product demand with a small scale launch before committing to larger amounts with a co-packer.

#### **Research Options**

Consider a wide range of manufacturers including those who do not advertise broadly as offering co-packing services.

#### **Focus The Search**

Prioritize requirements for production, minimum order size, certifications, sourcing, storage, shipping, quality control and expertise.

#### **Be Prepared**

Identify the most important product benefits to guide decisions related to any changes needed.

#### **Protect Your Business**

Gather references from other companies and have a business contract in place that is reviewed by your legal advisors.

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# **Search Tips**

Finding co-packers can be challenging. These tips will help you find the right partner for your business.

- Expand the search to include manufacturers who do not advertise broadly as co-packers.
- Reach out to manufacturers that make different products but use similar equipment, ingredients, temperature controls and storage.
- Check with ingredient and packaging suppliers for leads.
- Reach out to industry associations, government departments and attend trade shows that align with your product category and target consumers.
- Use a variety of online search words to find small or unique companies that do not appear in standard search results.
- Consider purchasing specialized or required equipment that would be used by the co-packer.





# **Questions To Ask**

These questions will help you get started. Continue to research to find the right partner for your business.

- Can they make your product as is or are changes needed for ingredients, packaging or other features?
- Do they meet all provincial and federal regulations for producing and distributing across Canada and beyond?
- What quality control systems or 3rd party certifications are in place?
- What are the minimum order quantities (MOQ's)?
- What is the lead time once an order is placed?
- Will they source and store ingredients and packaging or does the brand owner manage this?
- Does the price include product development, testing, ingredients, packaging, storage and shipping?
- Will they sign a non-disclosure or exclusivity agreement to protect brand confidentiality?
